


Suiti Cultural Heritage Foundation

- founded in 2013 in the Alsunga village with the aim to preserve, protect and develop Suiti Cultural Space which is included in UNESCO List of Intangible Cultural Heritage since 2009
- the main target group about 2,500 residents of Suiti community (Alsunga, Jūrkalne and Gudenieki)
- Board members: Kristīne Vasiļevska Stepanova, Juris Lipsnis, Māra Rozentāle
- Public benefit organisation status since 2022, granted by the State Revenue Service


